CCTV'S MISSION STATEMENT

Empowering people to communicate and providing community information through television.



DEMOCRACY AND THE FIRST AMENDMENT

All people in a democracy have the right and responsibility to take part in the decisions that affect them and their communities. Freedom of speech is vital to a healthy democracy and is guaranteed in the First Amendment. CCTV provides the community with the opportunity for political, cultural, artistic, spiritual, and individual expression on television.

COMMUNITY DECISION MAKING

Freedom of expression alone is not enough to ensure a healthy democracy. Citizens must also enter into active discussion and debate in order to participate in solving problems for the common good. CCTV promotes the use of non-commercial channels 21, 22, 23 and production facilities as an electronic forum for discussing issues and solving problems.

ACCESS TO INFORMATION

A well-informed, actively-involved citizenry makes more responsible decisions. CCTV televises local government meetings, activities of local schools and service-related information to stimulate an active dialogue among elected officials, schools and local citizens.

DIVERSITY AND INCLUSIVENESS

Democracy is most effective in a society in which all members can participate. CCTV encourages understanding and collaboration across barriers of race, culture, language, class, gender and age.

MEDIA LITERACY

Community TV offers an alternative to commercial television. CCTV provides the training and tools necessary for people to become knowledgeable and effective communicators, able to view television critically and to use that medium to tell their own stories.





In the past year, we built on our 2011 HD production truck and prepared for full conversion to HD, including the selection of a Channel Master Control System that will deliver HD programs to the home! While the year had little of the flash of the years before or after, we're proud of our accomplishments, ones made so much bigger and better by our community volunteers.

Better production and editing: the Anderson Meeting Rooms and FCPX

In March we completed installation and testing a robotic camera set-up in the Anderson Meeting Rooms of the Salem Public Library. This equipment will help us to cover more Salem Council work sessions and to cover events in the library.

We also converted our editing to Final Cut Pro 10, or FCPX as it's known. We waited about a year for updates and improvements to this new editing software, and bugs still exist. The user interface, or screen and commands used by the editor, has the first substantial change since CCTV began using much earlier versions of Final Cut Pro. Staff and community producers worked hard to make a smooth transition.

In production, CCTV handled the most challenging production period we've faced. Due to an unfortunate scheduling conflict, the OSAA state choir and instrumental competitions were held at the same time. CCTV covered both in HD, thanks to a huge commitment by volunteers and staff. We are proud of this work that resulted in about 50 hours programs featuring more than 130 high school music groups.

Better Distribution, Promotion & Visibility

CCTV selected Tightrope Cablecast and Carousel, replacing an outdated Synergy channel delivery system. Cablecast will enable us this autumn to deliver a digital picture that is cleaner and better, and will then deliver HD channels when the cable TV franchise renewal with Comcast is complete. Carousel will enable us to use the channels for much more program promotion. When you add in our increased use of social media, CCTV

What's Next

The next twelve months should be action packed. We expect to install and begin use of the Tightrope channel delivery system, and to soon put programs into the home in HD! We'll upgrade our studios to HD, completing the conversion. We'll be working on ways to gain visibility and to better give our community a presence on the dominant media. We envision a banner year in our work to build community through television and the web.




In July, Training Coordinator Greg Hiltz led CCTV's Summer Video Camp, bringing 38 students through our doors to learn about video production.




